### Transactional vs. Transformational Leadership



#### **Transactional Leaders**

occur when followers are moved to complete their roles as agreed with a leader in exchange for a reward.

- ► Focus on goals
- Use rewards and punishments for motivation
- Are reactive in nature



#### Transformational Leaders

move followers to awareness about what is important, and away from own self-interests.

- ► Focus on vision
- Use charisma and enthusiasm for motivation
- Are proactive in nature

### Transactional operations....

- Fund individual programs in broad categories
- Respond only to those who find us.
- Respond to any request within our priorities.
- Exhibit an attitude of scarcity by viewing our value through limited funds. (i.e. weekly offering, annual fund)
- Foster fragmented, competitive investing across our many funding streams.

### Transformational operations....


• Align funding and activities to achieve connectional outcomes among other churches in the area or same focus community organizations vital to sustaining and growing our people and they ministries you serve.

• Increase active community presence and engagement to identify new partners.

• Focus on systems and proactive alignment of networks and collaborations.

- Exhibit an attitude of abundance by demonstrating our priorities and providing value through every interaction and activity. This is the why!
- Align funding streams to the extent possible, work closer with other funding partners to increase vision and goals of your Church..
