Understanding "Dones"

**Many individuals leaving mainline churches are not abandoning faith altogether but are seeking spiritual fulfillment outside traditional church structures.

WHY??**



Perceived Institutional Irrelevance

Some feel that churches are not addressing contemporary social and personal issues effectively.

"Completed" purpose for attending (raised kids, served a project, etc)



Desire for Authentic Community:

A longing for deeper, more meaningful connections than what is found in traditional congregations.

More than going through the motions



Disillusionment with Church Politics:

Frustration over internal conflicts and politicization within church leadership and governance.

Burned out on relationships

What Are We To Do?

- Addressing Internal Conflicts: Resolve theological and political disputes can help prevent further disaffiliations and restore unity.
- Innovating Worship and Community Models: Adapt to contemporary needs by offering diverse forms of worship and community engagement, including a balanced approach to discipleship.

Reevaluate Engagement Strategies: Explore new ways to connect with individuals seeking spiritual growth outside traditional services.

Small Groups: Societies

Definition: The largest and most general grouping in early Methodism.

Purpose: Gathered people for worship, teaching, and encouragement in the faith.

Membership: Open to all who desired to flee from the wrath to come and be saved.

Structure: Functioned similarly to a local church, often meeting weekly.

Content: Included preaching, singing, prayer, and general instruction in the Christian life.

Small Groups: Classes

Definition: Small groups of about 10-12 people drawn from the society.

Purpose: Practical support and accountability in Christian living.

Membership: Required for those who wanted to remain part of the society.

Structure: Met weekly, led by a class leader who offered spiritual guidance and checked on each person's walk with God.

Content: Members would share how their souls prospered, confess struggles, and receive encouragement. The class leader collected a weekly offering to help the poor.

Small Groups: Bands

Definition: Even smaller groups (usually 4-5 people) organized by gender and marital status.

Purpose: Deep, voluntary accountability and confession of sin.

Membership: Optional, and only for those seeking deeper holiness.

Structure: Highly confidential, honest, and committed.

Content: Members answered specific questions about temptations and sins, helping one another toward sanctification.
